Scoring for Teams

80 – 85cm height first round with a 90cm Jump Off

4 Faults per rail

4 faults per stop

3 stops = Elimination

1 time penalty per second over the time allowed

- 3 riders scores are added together and lowest score wins
- If there is more than one team on Equal First then there will be a jump off. – Each team member to go again against the clock.
- Lowest penalty with the fastest time is the winner

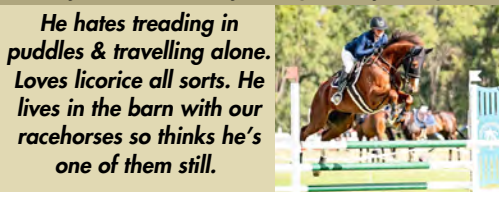

Jemma has had Gwynn for 10 years and rode him in the Maiden Teams at TSHA Nationals 2023 for a 4th place and has had numerous wins at hacking, dressage, eventing and showjumping. Sir Gwynn won the Open Novice Dressage at Equimillions 2023 ridden by Kaden Weaver.



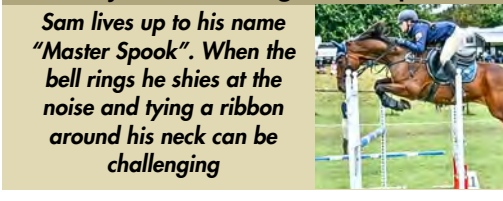
